And as Ed said: *If you don't know what's in your backyard, what do you really know!* Lisa and Ed have increased the Bay County plant species list by adding over 600 species !! as well as "re-discovering" the Panama City Crayfish. Lisa also recommended the Sibley Field Guide to Birds.

**SPECIAL Thanks to Jim Moyers:** who discussed non-native invasive plants and animals. Plus he recommended the Apple 'I-touch' & 'I-Phone'. Applications are available online, only through I-tunes. Note that the "apps" run only on the two devices listed above. I have heard these apps may be adapted to run on certain Blackberries that utilize applications as well. The iBird Explorer Plus covers all North American bird species, \$12.99. Tree-ID covers all tree species in North America, \$9.99. Also, recommended reading "Looking for Longleaf: The Fall and Rise of the American Forest".
