The Sky Tells a Story: The **Geminid Meteor Shower** peaks on the morning of 14 Dec.

Mercury is visible in the first week of December low in the SW twilight, then passes between us and the Sun, and is visible in the morning sky during the last week of the month. **Venus** dominates the morning sky. **Jupiter** is the brightest object in the SW evening skies. **Saturn** rises in **Virgo** about midnight.

The great square of **Pegasus** dominates the western sky. **Cassiopeia** makes a striking W in the NW. You can use her to find the **North Star** as she is 180 degrees opposite of the **Big Dipper**. Her daughter, **Andromeda**, starts with the NE corner star of Pegasus' Square, and goes NE with two more bright stars in a row. To the NE, Andromeda's hero, **Perseus**, rises. Look at Perseus' feet for **Pleiades**, the 7 Sisters. East of Pleiades is the V of stars marking the face of **Taurus** the Bull, with bright orange **Aldebaran** as his eye.

Yellow **Capella**, a giant star the same temperature and color as our much smaller Sun, dominates the NE sky. It is part of the pentagon on stars making up **Auriga**, the Charioteer. East of Auriga, the twins, **Castor** and **Pollux** highlight **Gemini**.

South of Gemini, **Orion** is the most familiar winter constellation, dominating the eastern sky by 8 PM. The reddish supergiant **Betelgeuse** marks his eastern shoulder, while blue-white supergiant **Rigel** stands opposite on his west knee.
