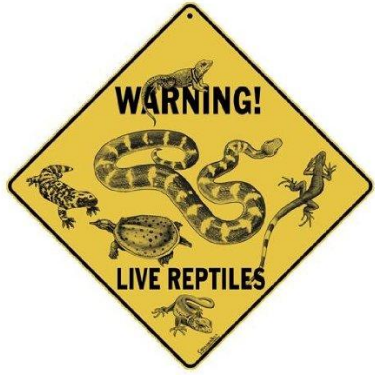

The Sky Tells a Story: **Geminid Meteor Shower peaks 14 Dec.** Major activity last almost 24 hours during peak time. Produces bright, medium-speed meteors – up to 80 per hour – the most reliable meteor shower and easy to observe – best seen after midnight.
