

Troop 317 Code of Conduct

The following guidelines are a practical application of the **Scout Oath and Scout Law**, and are meant to govern the conduct and behavior of our Scouts during all Troop Scouting events and activities:

- 1. I will strive to act in a responsible manner at all times and to be truthful and honest with my fellow Scouts and Leaders.**
- 2. I will make every effort to be helpful towards fellow Scouts and Scout Leaders.**
- 3. I will exhibit friendly behavior towards all my fellow Scouts at all times. I will not engage in name-calling, ridicule, teasing or provoking of others. Under no circumstances will I become hostile or aggressive in a verbal or physical way towards fellow Scouts or any other person.**
- 4. I will show respect and be courteous towards all adults, youth leaders and fellow Scouts.**
- 5. I will try to practice kindness towards all my fellow Scouts.**
- 6. I will obey all youth leaders and adults.**
- 7. I will make every effort to remain cheerful rather than grumbling and complaining in spite of the circumstances.**
- 8. I will be clean in my speech and actions and will not use language that is crude, vulgar or obscene.**

I understand that if I repeatedly disregard these guidelines during Scout activities, I may be asked to appear before the Troop Patrol Leader's Council. Serious violations such as fighting, theft, vandalism and destruction of property will require a conference with you and your parents, the Scoutmaster and at least one other adult Troop Leader, and may lead to a possible suspension from Troop activities for a determined period of time.
