

## Youth Programs

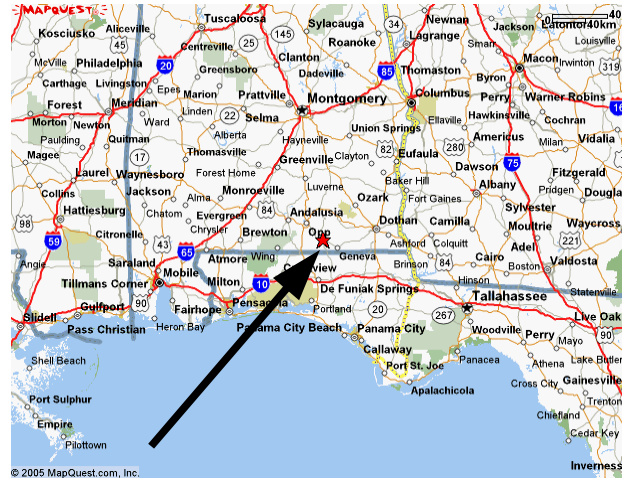
SEARS is committed to outreach for schools and youth groups. We give rocketry demos and talks throughout the year.

## Launch Info



We enjoy launching low, mid and high Power rockets. There is no motor max. For H motors and larger, you must be NAR or TRA certified for the motor impulse range. Membership at SEARS is not required to launch. NAR/TRA Safety Codes apply at SEARS launches.

Our FAA waiver allows up to 10000' AGL. However, the altitude limit will vary based on setup location and winds.

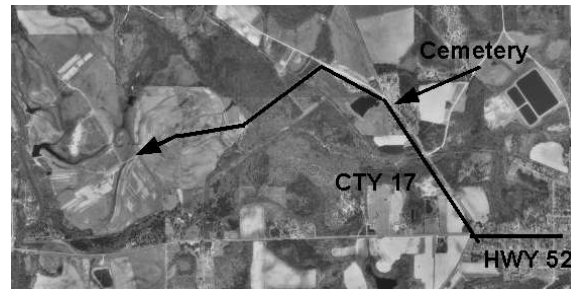
All launch equipment is provided including support for non-goxy hybrids. There is a \$10 range fee for fliers 19 and up

Our usual schedule is equipment setup at 8:30, launching starts at 9:00 and equipment tear down at 4:00.



## Directions from Samson, AL

From the intersection of AL 52 and AL87 (downtown Samson), go west on 52 0.9 miles to County 17 and turn right. Go 0.8 miles on County 17; with a cemetery on the right, and just past a pond, turn left onto a wide graded dirt road. You will come to a short paved section and at 0.4 miles onto this road turn left at the SEARS Sign onto one lane dirt road down into woods. Cross railroad track and continue straight ahead past the sod farm offices into the middle of the field. Observe the signs.



## SEARS Membership
